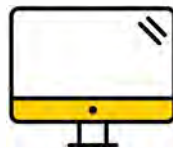

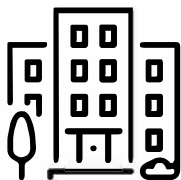


AFTER THE EXAM
