The Graduate Management Admission Council (GMAC) is delighted to share the stories of the ten outstanding recipients of the GMAT™ Talent and Opportunity Scholarship 2024 (Europe).

Selected from over **200 applicants across 23 countries**, the winners share one defining trait: they are global problem solvers. Each of them has committed to addressing a significant challenge, whether that challenge affects their own community or us all worldwide.

The deserving winners will be awarded a scholarship that includes a voucher to cover the full cost of the GMAT Exam; a GMAT Official Practice Exam package and a meditation application subscription. In addition, thanks to the generosity of industry partners, winners will receive a GMAT preparation course with a GMAT instructor, sessions from a professional admissions consultant, and an online cultural course for applicants who plan to study abroad. The total value of the scholarship is close to €4,500.

Scholarship purpose



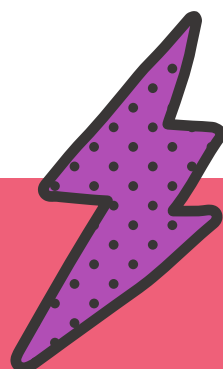
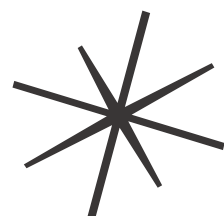
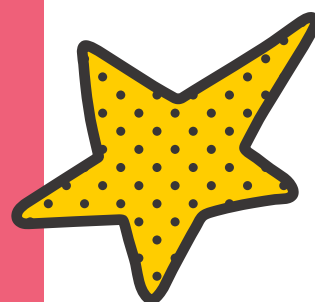
My Story
