

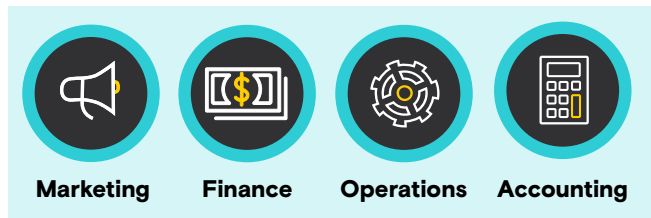
What can I get from an MBA?

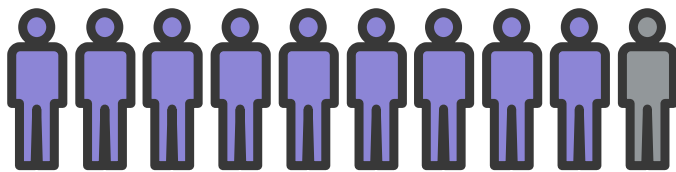

full-time MBA graduates agree that the skills they developed in business school moved them further along in their career compared with peers without an MBA degree.

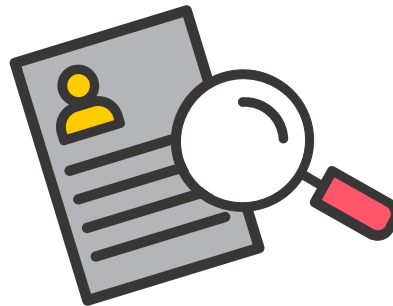

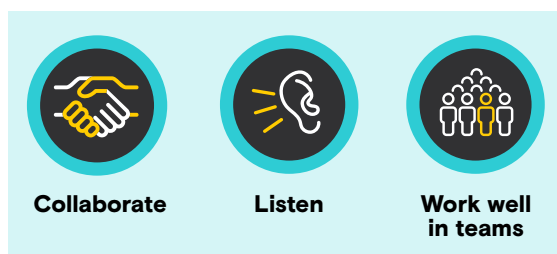
